They will have a comprehensive review to consolidate the basic knowledge of elementary school; 2 half-days for mock exams, 0.5 half-day for exam analysis; 1.5 half-day for read-write-present stories; 0.5 half-day for dictation, 0.5 half-day for activities including music , art crafts and more. On-site camp will also have pool and other outdoor activities.</p> <p>The program of preparation for secondary school entrance exam include three steps:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Weekdend courses include grammars, reading comprehension and writing in French and logic/math courses. 2) Courses of Summer Camp: includes intensive revisions and practical exams to help students adapt to different exams. 3) Intensive preparation courses for the exam: End of August to beginning of October, students will have academic and psychological preparations for the admission exams.
